CHURCH COUNCIL SUMMARY

A Church Council Meeting was held on Monday 21st November 2016

The following items were considered:

- Discussion took place on obtaining a defibrillator for the church premises.
- The church deficit has been significantly reduced in the past quarter.
- Church Council agreed annual donations to Connexional Funds (Home Missions, World Development & Relief Fund and Methodist Missionary Society), and agreed continued support of CAP, Scripture Union and UCB.
- A new sound desk has been purchased. Some further installation is necessary, but it is hoped it will be operational soon. As part of the sound system upgrade speakers are to be put into the Crèche and Foyer areas.
- Some new furniture (including chairs and a large boardroom table) has been donated to the church from Youth Justice Agency in Lisburn, and 50 other good quality used chairs are to be purchased. This will complement our church furniture.
- Renewable Partnerships: A new deal has been negotiated to help cut the cost of our utility bills. Thanks to David Twyble, Alan Grant, & John Moore.
- New / more volunteers are needed for the Car Boot Sales.
- Sabbaticals are due for some Ministers on the Circuit, including David, in the 2017/18 church year.
- The Methodist Conference is taking place at Trinity from 14th to 18th June 2017. There will be approximately 300 delegates. Volunteers are needed from the circuit to serve Tea / Coffee and for car-park stewarding at Trinity and Lisburn Free Presbyterian Church.
- A United Circuit Sunday morning Pentecost worship service will be held on 4th June 2017.
