A Church Council Meeting was held on Wednesday 23rd May 2018

The following items were considered:

- Julie Budd, Lesley Grattan and John Magee were thanked for their contribution to Church Council over the past three years.
- A letter of thanks was received from Scripture Union for the complimentary use of our church facilities. This was for an event which helped them to raise £800 to support our local SU schools' worker.
- The need for disabled access to the platform at the front of the church was highlighted.
- The All-in Conference Day held recently was inspirational and enjoyed by all who attended.
- More volunteers are needed to help with our Summer Bible Club.
- The use/ purchase of new computer software to aid in our worship was discussed.
- Recording sermons for use by those unable to attend church was considered.
- The uptake of prayer ministry at the front of the church has been a positive step forward.
- An Evacuation Drill on a Sunday morning is to be held soon.
- We need a group of able-bodied people to help move chairs, clean up etc. when Mark (TCI) is unavailable. This could be coordinated using a 'WhatsApp' group.
- £500 is to be donated to the Gideons International.
